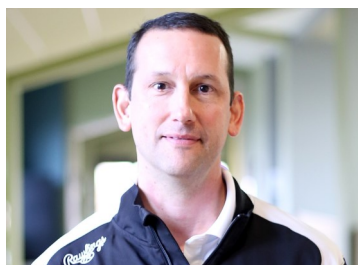

We will be covering topics such as salvation, baptism, our Constitution, core doctrines, and philosophy of ministry. Thank you for your interest.

On 9/22, we will be offering an immunization clinic in the TTCA Gym, offering flu shots to people 5 years of age or older (provided children can be controlled by a parent/guardian), tetanus (TDAP), shingles (Shingrix), and pneumonia immunizations to adults who qualify.

These immunizations will be administered by a licensed pharmacist, and most are covered totally, or mostly, by insurance. To find out if your insurance will cover the cost of any immunization, to see if you qualify for age requirements on some immunizations, or if you have any questions, please call Rite Aid at 607-733-5202. If you plan on getting any of the offered immunizations aside from a flu shot, you must call this number in advance to register. ALL must bring their insurance cards to the clinic.

Benefits are no Dr. visit (or co-pay), and in the current COVID climate, being immunized from these illnesses may help to avoid trips to urgent care/hospitals. Most importantly, these immunizations may keep you from the effects of these illnesses.
