Ryan & Joy are currently working among college students at the country's largest university, the University of Ghana.



Originally in 2014, our intention was to plant churches and aid in national leadership.

After serving several years we have realized our role is to disciple and challenge the young adults to share Christ and make disciples. We have also taken a "sideline" role as we work to encourage and support the national pastors across the country who

have small and struggling works. After the Lord led us to move to Accra, we soon discovered that some of the ministries had never been formally "nationalized." As one of the administrators, I felt impressed by the Lord and His word to work towards "nationalization" from a biblical standpoint as well as a local perspective. We have officially handed the clinic over to a well competent and qualified board. God has also allowed us in 2020 to begin the "weaning" process of our 60 year old Bible college. We now have a functioning national board in place; many, of whom, are graduates and desire to have their churches involved in the college long term.

Woman Loses Business and Home to Fire**

When the restaurant she owned and operated was burned six months after she became a believer, Faridah assumed it had been an accident. But earlier this year, the two rooms she rented in a home were also burned, and neighbors mentioned smelling gasoline.

Faridah lost everything she owned and now suspects her relatives were responsible for the fires. After being abandoned by her husband, her relatives had been helping raise her six children. But when she became a

Christian, they cursed her and told her she would never have peace as long as she was a Christian. Her landlord is also demanding reimbursement for his loss. Pray that God will meet the needs of Faridah and her family and that they will remain strong in faith.
