Life Group Questions

CONNECT:

In our text this week Jesus is going to command us to "strive to enter through the narrow door." In light of that, what was the tightest space you've ever found yourself in? What was the occasion and how did it make you feel?

GROW:

- What part of today's message impacted you the most and why?
- What's the danger of only being familiar with Jesus without actually knowing Him by faith? How can sin deceive someone into thinking that knowing about Jesus, singing songs to Jesus, or doing things for Jesus is enough to save them?
- The Book of Revelation presents a global, but not universal, view of salvation in that heaven will be filled with people from every ethnicity on the planet. What part of that reality is your responsibility? How does that impact the way you're living your life right now?
- How would you explain to an unbeliever the fact that Christianity is and is not "exclusive"? How would you explain the difference between the exclusivity of Christianity and the predominately pluralistic and relativistic worldview of our day that is assumed to be true by so many people?

MULTIPLY:

One of the blessings of this present season is that people's false saviors are being exposed for what they are. How can you leverage that reality to make more and better disciples of Christ? How can your Life Group be helpful to you in that?
